Congratulations also go to our students who participated in our **Community of Small Schools' Touch Football** gala day at Uranquinty last Friday. It seems as though everyone had a wonderful time, increased their sporting skills and reconnected with old friends and made some new friends as well.

This week is another big week of learning at school. On Thursday we are working with the **Riverina Environmental Education Centre on a STEM** (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) project based on birds' nests. We will be observing a number of nests built by a variety of birds for different purposes. We will consider the use of man-made vs natural materials used and get to create our own bird's nest. We are one of the first schools in the Riverina to trial this project and are very excited to be working with Dayelle from REEC.

Swim School is coming up again. We have decided to run it at the end of the year rather than the start of next year when we will be settling our new kindergarten students into school. It is going to cost \$130 for each child to participate but we have a number of grants to help and school is going to subsidise this event as well which will reduce the <u>cost to \$50 a child</u>.

This week we have been finalising our learning on government in the Primary section, reflecting on all we have learnt.
