Positive Mental Health

This term in health (PD/H/PE) we are looking at building strong and positive mental health in our students. Each week we will be focusing on something different to allow our students to grow their mental health in a positive way. This week's lesson was about persistence. We discussed that it means never giving up, even when it is tough. We looked at our feelings and talked about feelings like: feeling scared, stressed, frustrated, sad, angry mad or anxious. We talked about how feeling these ways might effect our thoughts and how we think about different situations. During this week at home we would invite you to discuss persistence and look for ways to find examples in your/their daily lives where you/they used persistence not to give up. Having a strong mental health is important for our wellbeing.
