On Thursday 19th September all Australians are being asked to stop what they are doing for one hour and pick up a book. It's a time to rediscover the benefits of reading, to learn, to escape and to relax. Department of Education Secretary, Mark Scott, said Australian Reading Hour helped young people discover the joy of reading and could contribute to improved literacy. Families are encouraged to join the national program at home and read a bedtime story. Studies show that reading a bedtime story six days a week can give kids almost a year's head start when they start school. Reading has also been shown to develop empathy, promote critical thinking and help children find a sense of self.
