### Check-In Assessments

This week all of our Primary students have participated in the department's Check-In Assessment tests. You may recall that we had access to this tool in Term 1 and 2 and now we are following up to check student growth and achievement in the last six months.

### Tell Them From Me surveys

Students in Yr 4-6 will be participating in the TTFM survey. It asks our students a series of questions about how they feel about their school and their sense of belonging. All students K-6 have also completed some wellbeing surveys which is important to us to help support your child with their wellbeing. We are also sending home a parent survey and are looking for your point of view on how your child is going and how the school is supporting them.
