### High School Orientation Programs

Next Friday WWHS are holding a ZOOM session for the Year 6 students to learn more about what life is like in high school. On Tuesday 23rd November both WWHS and GHS will be holding transition days at their schools for our Year 6 students to attend.

### Child Protection Lessons

Over the next 5 weeks we will be completing our mandatory child protection lessons K-6. In these programs we look at keeping ourselves safe and who to turn to if we need help or are feeling scared. The Primary class will have one lesson where the body parts will be named. ### Primary Cyber Safety Lessons

We are in the process of organising a visit from our local Police Youth Engagement Officer, Troy Fisher. He will be running a transition program looking at educating our students of the laws surrounding cyber safety, bullying behaviour, assaults, graffiti, malicious damage and the Young Offender's Act. We will let you know when this is organised. As our students are spending more and more time online in programs like Minecraft and Among Us it is a good time for this conversation. Since our students aren't allowed to have social media accounts until they are 13, it is good to have these conversations before they start to use these programs.

A big thank you to everyone who has found their wide-brimmed legal hats. In Term 4 we operate a No Hat No Play system in the playground. Please take the time this week to find your hats and bring them to school everyday. They must be legal hats (bucket hat or wide brim hat).
