Gymnastics—Term 1, 2019

We will be doing gymnastics in Term 1 for 8 weeks. The cost will be \$55 per student and you can start paying this off now if you would like to reduce the cost next term. Little Champions Gymnastics will be bringing their van of gymnastics equipment for us to use and it will be a lot of fun.

What have we been learning in class?

This week we have been doing some revision in maths and students have been able to select which areas of maths they would like to learn more about. The most popular area has been using tally marks to record survey results and then create graphs from the data. The second most popular area has been addition and subtraction. It is always interesting to see what our students are interested in. In English we have been continuing our focus on improving reading fluency and trying to ensure that when we read it sounds just like it sounds when we are talking. We have been very impressed with our Kindergarten students who are reading between 50-60 words per minute of their levelled reader and our Year Ones and Twos are between 80-90 words per minute. This has been an outstanding effort by all of our Infants students who are learning about goal setting and independent learning skills. Most of our Primary students are reading in excess of 120 words per minute and are now focussing on their comprehension skills. This week we have had our final Bluearth session with Sarah. It has been wonderful to see how far our students have come not only with their PE and skill development but in how they solve problems and are more resilient in how they approach things. In Music we have been making good progress with our items for Presentation Night and we look forward to performing for you.
