## What have we been learning in class?

Tennis has been the biggest learning curve this week. Students have been learning how to balance a ball on their racquet, how to bounce the ball on the racquet, how to hit it over the net and how to serve the ball. We have been also working on our resilience, giving new skills a good go and not giving up when the learning pushes us out of our comfort zone.
